We know the kids we serve need consistency and safety. So our doors are open year-round to students and their families with targeted programming to meet their needs day in and day out.

A Better World provides a no-cost annual Summer Enrichment Program to prevent summer Min reading loss in our youth. Nothing serves as better motivation than our Summer Celebration Trip to the happiest place on earth. And during the school year, we utilize i-Ready to provide 300+ students with personalized, interactive lessons to improve their reading skills through NC DPI. i-Ready allows us to track their progress and ensure our youth are reading at grade level, Our Free Afterschool Program provides students with homework assistance with certified instructors and rides to and from our facility.

Body. Every day when our students walk through the doors of our facility, they receive a nutritious snack, and before they leave for the evening, a hot meal prepared in our kitchen at the Kid's Cafe. Thanks to Jubilee Farms and other organizations who believe in our mission, we're able to care J for students and their families when they leave A Better World to go home with food through our Backpack + Food Truck Fridays programs. So everyone has a backpack full of healthy food over the weekend and full, hearty holiday meals during Thanksgiving and Christmas time. Additionally, our families are able to shop at our GoodSenseStore for basic necessities at little to no cost for household items. Our Families First initiative was a response to COVID-19 and helped pay rent and deliver food at the front door of households who were quarantined.

There has always been a need for preventative therapy in West Charlotte since the risk of Spirit. substance abuse is much greater in low-income communities. At A Better World, we are equipping students with the tools to combat toxic stress and risk factors with free, confidential, and preventative counseling through **Be Well Therapy** that can be accessed anywhere. And we utilize Daily Devotionals and our Prayer Program to raise up the next generation becoming men and women dependent on God and expectant of His deliverance.
